Modifying Windows AgentBuilder.bat File

In certain cases, if the user's system user name contains an embedded blank character (e.g., "John Smith"), the AgencyViewer in AgentBuilder Pro will not work properly. This problem is easy to overcome with a simple modification to the AgentBuildeer.bat File. This file can be found in the AgentBuilderPro1.4 directory. If you used the default values on installation it will probably be located in C:\Program Files. Edit the AgentBuilder.bat file as described below.

The file probably looks something like this:

All you need to do is modify the line beginning "\jre\bin\java by inserting the directive: -Duser.name=myusername

If you want to use the word "smith" as your user name then your AgentBuilder.bat file should now look like this:

```

Save the changes and restart AgentBuilder.
